Mike Mullen updated the Commissioner in relation to the sale of the Northumbria Police Headquarters site in Ponteland.

Richard Heron updated the Commissioner on ongoing correspondence in relation to the use of Pilgrim Street Cells by Her Majesty's Court Service.

Simon Tait gave an overview on the current work of the media team including the attendance of Northumbria Police at LGBT Pride Events in both Newcastle and Sunderland.

The Commissioner was also updated on a number of campaigns that the media team are currently developing including anti-social behaviour and legal highs.
