222018	What budget has your Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner set aside for the costs associated with commissioning Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) services? This might include staff costs, legal costs, cost of market engagement events etc. Please supply the answer as total budget for the financial year 2018/19.	There is no set budget for costs associated with commissioning Violence against Women and Girls (VAWG) services. The staff costs that can be attached to VAWG commissioning is the salary of the Interim Director of Commissioning, Engagement and Policy – approximately 50% of this posts time is spent ensuring the effective commissioning of victim services, and approximately 70% of services commissioned by Northumbria OPCC are associated with VAWG therefore the annual spend attached to this post is £18,971.40 (excluding on-costs). Using the same calculations an annual spend of £11,876.55 can be attributed to the role of the Partnership and Community Engagement Officer. We plan to spend £30,847.95 in 2018-19 on costs associated with commissioning. Each year we commission specialist services to meet the needs of victims in Northumbria who have experienced violence and abuse. For example we commission specialist services for BAME women and children, male victims, those with more complex needs and stalking victims.
