National Police Air Services Collaboration Agreement (PCC/22/2013)

Joint report of the Chief Executive, Treasurer and Chief Constable

Summary

The Secretary of State has made an order under Section 22A of the Police Act 1996 to specify that air support as a function is to be carried out through a single national collaboration agreement for England and Wales. The National Police Air Service is being led by West Yorkshire Police which has acted jointly with the National Policing Improvement Agency. The National Police Service collaboration agreement has now been received for approval by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Northumbria.

Recommendation/ Findings:

It is recommended that the Commissioner approve the National Police Air Services collaboration agreement and to execute the same by 1 April 2013 and execute all necessary deeds of novation in connection with related contracts.
