Disposal of Former Jarrow Police Station

Report of the Chief Constable's Director of Finance

Summary

The former Jarrow Police Station was vacated in 2013.

The property has not been open to the public or used as a base for neighbourhood policing teams since at least 2004.

The Chief Constable has declared the property surplus to operational requirements.

Recommendations / Findings

It is recommended that the Commissioner agrees to declare the property surplus to requirements and authorises the Chief Constable's Director of Finance to arrange disposal of the properties.
