#### **Summary**

The Estates Strategy envisages the establishment of neighbourhood bases within the community and the disposal of freehold premises where alternative locations can be identified. The Estates team have identified suitable premises at Arms Everytne House comprising a self contained ground floor office with shared use of amenities.

The Commissioner is asked to agree to:

- (i) The acquisition of a lease of space within Arms Everytne House, Blyth in accordance with the provisional terms set out above.
- (ii) The marketing and disposal of Blyth Police Station.
