- There are many different people who live in Northumbria and I will try to make sure everyone's policing needs are met.


5. Shaping the Plan

6. Police and Crime Objectives

- The plan has 5 important things. These are:
 - o Putting victims first
 - o Dealing with anti-social behaviour
 - o Domestic and sexual abuse
 - o Cutting crime
 - o Making people feel safe







Putting Victims First

- Why is this important?
 - o Being a victim of crime can stop you from feeling safe and can make you unhappy.
- How we will listen to victims of crime:
 - o We will talk to and listen to people who are victims of crime. This will help us improve our services.
 - o We want you to tell us if you are a victim so that we can help you.
 - o Please tell us if you are a victim of crime or anyone else is.
 - o We promise to keep in touch with you.









Dealing with Anti-Social Behaviour

- Why is this important?
 - o Anti-social behaviour can affect and upset everyone.
- How we will deal with anti-social behaviour:
 - o We want you to tell us if it is happening and we will try and stop the problem.
 - o We will encourage people to come forward and report their concerns.





Domestic and Sexual Abuse

- Why is this important?
 - o This kind of crime is often committed by partners or people you know.
- What we will do:
 - o We want you to tell us about these crimes.
 - o We will help and support you.



Cutting Crime

- Why is this important?
 - o Because crime hurts people.
- How we will cut crime:
 - o We will work with you to keep you safe.
 - o The police will try and catch criminals and take them to court.

Making People Feel safe

- Why is this important?
 - o We want people to feel safe.
- How we will make people feel safe:
 - o We will listen to you and work on the things that concern you the most.
 - o We will tell you how you can get in touch with your local police officers.
 - o We will provide safe places where you can report crimes.

Making it Happen

• We will all work together to make this happen and talk to you to see how the plan is working.


