Summary

The Estates Strategy envisages the establishment of neighbourhood bases within the community and the disposal of freehold premises such as Gillbridge Police Station. Sunderland City Council have expressed an interest in acquiring Gillbridge Police Station in an off-market transaction. An independent valuation has been commissioned and Sunderland City Council have offered to purchase the property at the same amount as recommended by the independent valuation.
