Allocation of Police Property Fund Money

Summary

The Police Property Act States property which comes into the possession of the police in connection with a crime and where the owner cannot be found can be sold, with the money being kept in the Police Property Act Fund

In a report to the OPCC Business Meeting on the 18th October 2016, it was reported that the balance for disposal was £145,973.

Recommendations / Findings

As in previous years, the Commissioner wishes to make payments to charitable organisations that support and help victims of crime. It is recommended that payments are made as follows;

- £5,000 to the National Ugly Mugs (NUM).
- £1,000 pa to the Police Arboretum Memorial Trust.
- £2,000 pa to the Care of police Survivors (Cops).
- £50,000 to Victims First Northumbria.

This therefore leaves £87,973 available for future disbursement.
