North East Regional Sub-functional Collaboration Agreement regarding Digital Forensics

#### 1. PURPOSE

1.1 To advise sign-off of a further sub-functional collaboration agreement in relation to Digital Forensics under an overarching regional collaboration agreement dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015 between the seven north east region forces.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATION

2.1 That the agreement is signed by the Chief Constable and the Commissioner with the amendment mentioned below.

### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Police and Crime Commissioner and Chief Constable have previously signed an overarching regional s.22A collaboration agreement between the seven north east forces (Northumbria, Durham, Cleveland, North Yorkshire, West Yorkshire, Humberside & South Yorkshire) dated 1 September 2015.
- 3.2 The overarching agreement sets out a general framework for specific collaborations with the detail of such collaborations to be set out in later sub-functional agreements and protocols.

Several sub-functional agreements have been signed off since 2015.

- 3.3 The lead force under the overarching agreement, West Yorkshire, has requested the sign off of a further sub-functional agreement relating to Digital Forensic Services provided by NECTU.
- 3.4 The structure of this sub-functional agreement is identical to the previous sub-functional agreements and consistent with the requirements of the overarching agreement. The main provisions are
  - Commencement date of 3 January 2018;
  - Details of the services provided under the agreement are set out in the SLA appended to it;
  - Funding is borne by NECTU from the Counter Terrorism Police Grant.
- 3.5 There are no legal or operational issues or concerns in relation to this sub-functional agreement. There is a minor amendment as the document refers to the old HQ address at Ponteland. This can be amended in manuscript and the amendment initialled by the Chief Constable and Commissioner

## 4. KEY OUTCOMES

4.1 The signing of this sub-functional agreement has no impact on existing policy or procedure and will formalise what is in effect already in place.

#### 1. SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

In this Agreement the terms below have the following meaning and are specific to the delivery of the Digital Forensic Services function.

- 1.1. "Digital Forensics" digital device examination, interpretation and investigation.
- 1.2. "Framework Agreement" the overarching North East Region Collaboration Agreement dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015.
- 1.3. **"Function"** the Digital Forensic services undertaken by North East Counter Terrorism Unit in accordance with the SLA.
- 1.4. "Lead Force" West Yorkshire Police.
- 1.5. "NECTU" North East Counter Terrorism Unit.
- 1.6. "SLA" the Service Level Agreement annexed hereto.
- 1.7. "This Agreement" This Collaboration Agreement for the provision of the Digital Forensic Service.

#### 2. SECTION 2: THE LEGAL CONTEXT

- 2.1. The Parties wish to enter into a Collaboration Agreement pursuant to Section 22A of Police Act 1996 for the provision of the Function.
- 2.2. This Agreement is made pursuant to the Framework Agreement and those terms and conditions are adopted and confirmed for the purposes of this Agreement.
- **2.3.** This Agreement constitutes a functional Collaboration as contemplated within the Framework Agreement.
- 2.4. The Lead Force is responsible for administrative matters only in regard to the Function. NECTU is responsible for conducting and/or managing all the operational work undertaken for the Function.
- 2.5. The Chief Constables are of the view that this Collaboration Agreement is in the interests of the efficiency or effectiveness of their respective Forces.
- 2.6. The Policing Bodies are of the view that this Collaboration Agreement is in the interests of the efficiency or effectiveness of the forces they maintain.
- 2.7. Where there is any inconsistency or conflict between the Framework Agreement and this Agreement, the terms of this Agreement shall be preferred and shall prevail.

#### 3. SECTION 3: THE PURPOSE OF THIS AGREEMENT

3.1. The Parties have agreed to the joint coordination of the Function via the Lead Force. The Parties have concluded that such functionality can most efficiently and effectively be achieved by NE CTU delivering the Function.

#### 4. SECTION 4: THE DIGITAL FORENSIC FUNCTION

4.1. The Function shall be carried out and performed in accordance with the SLA.

### 5. SECTION 5: COMMENCEMENT DATE, REVIEW AND DURATION

- 5.1. This Agreement shall come into force on **2<sup>nd</sup> day of January 2018** and shall continue until terminated or varied.
- 5.2. A review may be commissioned at any time by any of the Parties as per Section 7 of the Framework Agreement.
- 5.3. This Agreement (including the Annex) may be varied at any time by written agreement signed by all the Parties.

#### 6. SECTION 6: FINANCIAL RESOURCING

- 6.1. The costs of establishing maintaining and delivering the Function will be borne by NE CTU from funding made available from the CT Policing Grant provided by the Home Office.
- 6.2. Assets held for the purposes of the Function will be held by NE CTU.

### 7. SECTION 7: INSURANCE AND LIABILITIES

7.1 The Insurance and liabilities for the Function will be dealt with as per Section 16 of the Framework Agreement.

#### 8. SECTION 8: POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

8.1. The policies and procedures of the Lead Force relevant to the performance of the Function shall be used for the purpose of this Collaboration Agreement.

#### 9. **SECTION 9: STAFFING**

9.1. The coordination and tasking of the Function is NE CTU in conjunction with National Counter Terrorism Policing Headquarters.
