Your application should outline how you propose to use the fund to support the most vulnerable in your community in a way that enables you to continue to provide vital support services in these unprecedented times.

All applications should consider how they will contribute to the key aims:-

- Supporting victims
- Improve people's lives to prevent crime- support access to services for those in need of safeguarding or reduce reoffending
- Build community confidence.
