How many members of staff does your office have as of now, January 2020, and what is the current annual salary cost? 4. How many members of staff are paid an annual salary of more than £100,000 as of now, January 2020? 5. The salary for Police and Crime Commissioners throughout England and Wales is set by the Home Secretary, who accepted recommendations made about these in a report from the Senior Salaries Review Board. The salary is dependent upon the size of the force area. In 2012 the Northumbria PCC was paid a salary of £85,000, it is currently £86,700. (2% increase in 7 years) 2. When the OPCC was created in 2012, there were 35.16 members of staff, with an annual salary cost of £1,551,662. 3. The OPCC currently has 10.80 permanent members of staff with an annual cost of £461,834. 4. No members of staff as of January 2020 (or ever) have been paid more than £100,000. 5. As per the above.
