

The information provided in this document highlights all funding that has been awarded by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Northumbria during 2019/20. **Please note** that this document will be updated throughout the year if/when further funding is provided.

Funding has been split into two funding streams which are:

- **Supporting Victims Fund** with its purpose being to fund services to support victims of crime.
- **The Commissioners Community Fund** which allows groups, charities and organisations to apply for small grants to assist the PCC in delivering on her Police and Crime Plan priorities of Reducing ASB and Community Confidence.
- **Appropriate Adult Provision** through a partnership with Sunderland University for the provision of Appropriate Adults for those detained in Northumbria Police custody.
